**3. Organising Committee Address**

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**4. National Anthems – Flags**

All delegations are requested to bring a CD of their national anthem and their national flag (approx. size 150 cm x 100 cm). These must be handed to the OC Secretariat by the Head of Delegation upon arrival at the time of accreditation. During the closing banquet these will be returned to the delegation.

**5. Insurance**

The FIG Technical Regulations, Section 1, article 12.10 state that all participating Federations are responsible for a sufficient insurance coverage of all participating delegation members in case of illness and injury. The Organizing Committee will verify the insurance of all Federations at the accreditation. The Bulgarian Trampoline Federation or the FIG cannot be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents and the like.

**6. Official Language**

The official language of the World Cup is English. Interpretations from and into other languages must be organized by the delegations. Announcements will be made in English.

**7. Transportation**

Transfers from and to airport and railway station will be provided free of charge to those who book their accommodation with the Organizing Committee. There will also be free transportation provided between the competition venue and the official hotels.

## 8. Accreditations

When all the commitments are fulfilled, all delegation members will receive accreditations. The accreditation is personal, non transferable and compulsory to receive access to the training and competition hall, the lunch hall and the banquet. All participants and officials are required to wear the accreditations **at all times**. The accreditation of the delegations will be made on 3rd October 2012 (Thursday) from 14:00 to 20:00 in Dedeman Princess Hotel.

## 9. Competition Venue

The World Cup Trampoline & Tumbling will take place at: Arena Armeec Hall, Sofia, 1 Asen Yordanov Blvd.

## 10. Equipment

Trampoline: Eurotramp (4/4 mm bed)  
Tumbling Track: Acrosport

## 11. Lunch

Lunch at the Sport Hall will receive the Delegations, who stated it in advance at the Organizing Committee. Delegations, who would like to have extra lunch, could order such one day in advance by receiving tickets from the Organizing Committee. The price per ticket is 10 Euro per day.

## 12. Information Meeting

The information meetings for the World Cup and Sofia Cup for the Heads of Delegation (or representative of the delegation) will take place on 4<sup>th</sup> October 2012 (Thursday) 15:00 in the Sport Hall at the Press center, as follows:

**15.00-15.30** Orientation Meeting for the World Cup

**15.30-16.00** Orientation Meeting for Sofia Cup

The Organizing Committee will provide detailed information regarding the competitions. All information will be in English only.

**The information meeting is compulsory for all delegations.**

## 13. Judges Meeting

The judges meetings will be organized in the Sport Hall at the Press center on 4<sup>th</sup> October 2012 (Thursday), as follows:

**16.00-16.30** Judges Meeting – TRA World Cup

**16.30-17.00** Judges Meeting – TUM World Cup

**17.00-18.00** Judges Meeting – TRA, TUM and DMT Sofia Cup

**The Judges meeting is compulsory for all judges.**

## 14. Training

The training session will begin on 3<sup>th</sup> October 2012 (Wednesday) in the Training Hall. During training, it is only permitted to enter the competition and training hall for the competitors and coaches in conformity with the training schedule. The final training schedule will be handed out to the heads of delegation upon their arrival in Sofia.

## 15. Medical Services and doping control

A doctor and nurse will be available in the Competition venue. Doping controls can be organized by the local authorities and will be according the rules made by WADA and FIG. The doping controls can take place during training or competition.

## 16. Mailboxes

Mailboxes are going to be installed in the secretariat, providing various information. The Head of Delegations (or representative of the delegations) are asked to check their box on a regular basis. The information can be received only after presentation of mailbox card. All information requests and correspondence should be addressed to the Organizing Committee.

## 17. Drawing of Lots

The drawing of lots was made on 21<sup>st</sup> September 2012 in the FIG's Office in Lausanne.

## 18. Competition Cards

Competition cards must be returned in the secretariat at the sport venue on 4<sup>th</sup> October 2012 (Thursday) before 15:00 hours.

## 19. March in

The gymnasts are asked to assemble in the assembly area 5 minutes prior to each competition round for the march-in. They have to wear competition attire.

The Judges are asked to be on their panel places and welcome the competitors during each march-in.

## 20. Warm-up

Trampoline: Immediately prior to the Qualifying Round and the Finals each competitor/pair will be allowed a "one-touch" warm-up (max. 30 seconds) on the competition apparatus.

Tumbling: Immediately prior to the Qualifying Round and the Finals each competitor will be allowed 2 rounds of warm-up on the competition apparatus.

During the warm-up immediately prior to competition, the gymnasts are required to wear competition attire.

## 21. Inquires

All delegations are reminded about the rules about mark reviews (inquires). For details, see *FIG Technical Regulations, Section 1, article 8.4*.

## 22. Scores and Results

The results will be published, according to FIG Technical Regulations Section 1 Reg. 4.11.5, on an electronic score board provided by the organizer. After the competitions each delegation will receive a USB Flash drive with all the results.

## 23. Prize money

First place: CHF 1 500 - **1 140 €**

Second place: CHF 1 000 - **760 €**

Third place: CHF 500 - **380 €**

The prize money will be paid during the closing banquet. The prize money will be paid in Euros.

## 24. Medal Award Ceremonies

Only the medal winners are invited to participate and must appear in competition attire.

## 25. Closing Banquet

There will be a banquet (at the restaurant of Dedeman Princess Hotel) on 6<sup>th</sup> October 2012 (Saturday) at 21:00. The closing banquet is offered to the delegations, which have purchased accommodation from the Organizing Committee.

Delegations which want to participate in the closing banquet, but do not have tickets, can purchase tickets from the Organizing Committee on place. The ticket price is 20 € per person.
